Provisional list – Candidate internal prioritization

AGAUR FI 2023 - PROVISIONAL LIST - CANDIDAT INTERNAL PRIORITIZATION

The internal prioritization of the candidates for the "FI" predoctoral grants of the AGAUR has been made public on the intranet.

The following Core Scientific Committee members without conflict of interest prioritized the candidates of the FI AGAUR 2023 call: Hernando del Portillo, Joana Porcel, and Eva Casamitjana, according to the published criteria:

1. The weighted average grade of the academic file of the candidate individual (40%), calculated as specified in the call.
2. The assessment of the research group with which the candidate is affiliated (30%). ISGlobal faculty has been and periodically is evaluated externally by the External Advisory Committee, so current faculty have the full support from the centre providing to all groups the maximum 30% score for this item.
3. The institution's science policy (30%) is based on additional merits of the candidate based on his/her CV, including:
 - a. Student's mobility (research or training stays in different institutions) (20%);
 - b. Scientific publications (20%);
 - c. Communications to scientific conferences (20%);
 - d. Awards (20%)
 - e. Outstanding academic records (average grade in the academic file >9) (20%).

A motivation letter stating his/her interest in developing his/her research at ISGlobal would have been used to break between candidates with the same score, which was not the case for the current call.
