The ISGlobal-University of Barcelona Master of Global Health is designed to develop careers in health with a global and transdisciplinary perspective. The programme provides knowledge and tools necessary to tackle challenges in global health and to work with organisations that fight for equitable access to health around the world.

Master of Global Health

Programme

The Master of Global Health consists of 60 ECTS (European credits) or one academic year, running from September to June. It is organised in four modules and takes a participative approach based on case studies, problem solving and debate.

- Develop effective and sustainable solutions that improve health in a globalised world.

The Master of Global Health programme accepts candidates with diverse educational backgrounds (health and life sciences, social sciences, law, economics, etc.) who seek to develop or enhance careers in the field of global health with international organisations, NGOs, ministries of health, cooperation and development agencies, public-private partnerships and other actors in the international community interested in improving the health of populations around the world.
