Wind-Riding Microorganisms

Samples collected during airplane flights reveal that a wide diversity of microorganisms, some of them potentially pathogenic, can thrive in the troposphere – where they can travel vast distances on wind currents.



Big Steps Against a Silent Killer

Through a series of studies, our multidisciplinary teams are helping to improve TB diagnosis in children and people with HIV, assess its burden in prisons, and demonstrate the impact of poverty-reduction programs.



Clearing the Air

Our research and advocacy activities have contributed to a major public health victory: on October 2024, the European Parliament approved the adoption of stricter air quality standards that will benefit 450 million people across the EU.

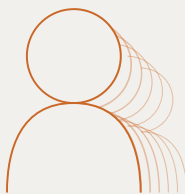
